## Important Information

## Special Needs

If you, a family member, or guest will need any assistance to participate, please let check in with an usher. Interpreting for the hearing impaired will be available during some services indicated on your ticket with an \*. Hearing amplification devices are available for use in the Spiegel Sanctuary and are located in a bin outside the sanctuary. We have large print Mahzorim (Prayer books.) Ask an usher for help.
